COURSE ETIQUETTE AND DRESS CODE

The management and members of The Vale Golf Club expect all guests and visitors to maintain a reasonable standard of dress at all times whilst on the course and in the clubhouse.

On Course

Recognised golf clothing should be worn at all times. No denim jeans, collarless shirts or tracksuits are permitted on either course.

Tailored shorts to be worn, no combat/cargo or external side pocketed, sports or beach shorts. Socks (knee length or sports) to be worn with shorts.

Please ensure golf shirts are tucked in at all times, no football or replica sports shirts are to be worn on the course or in the clubhouse.

Mobile phones may be only used in an emergency.

Golf shoes must be worn.

Please make use of our locker rooms for changing shoes and clothing and not the car park.

Clubhouse

Smart casual wear is permitted in the club bar and we encourage our members to refrain from wearing jeans.

No collarless shirts, sports or beach shorts or tracksuits are permitted.

Hats or baseball caps are not permitted to be worn in the clubhouse at any time.

No trainers are permitted in the bar area but are allowed on the patio area and in the Pro shop. Golf shoes with soft spikes may be worn.

Mobile phones are banned from the club bar.

Please do not be offended when asked to leave the bar or the course if you fail to observe the proper dress code and regulations.

Please help us by registering in the pro shop prior to play and arrive on the first tee 5 mins prior to play.

Respect other golfers by avoiding slow play and ensure all pitch marks are repaired and that bunkers are raked.

Please use defined pathways from greens to tees and do not cross over teeing areas with carts, trolleys or buggies.

Members wishing to receive calls should have their mobiles switched to silent/vibrate when in the bar.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Any person wishing to engage in photography or the recording of images of any kind are required to register their details with the management of the club prior to taking any such photography.
